

## **LECTURER IN FINANCE & ACCOUNTANCY**

In addition, the College has widened its scope as a Scottish Qualifications Authority (SQA) Centre delivering a range of customised awards and Higher National qualifications.

Applications are invited for the position of Lecturer in Finance and Accountancy.

Candidates should have a PhD or equivalent in a relevant area (or be close to completion), together with significant teaching experience in relevant subjects at HE level. The person appointed will be expected to engage in high quality research and teaching on the range of programmes offered by the College.

A record of publishing in world-leading, peer-reviewed journals in Finance and Accountancy is required along with an ability to supervise postgraduate and PhD students. Candidates should have the ability to advance their own research area, the flexibility to collaborate with colleagues and the ability to work well in a team. They should have excellent communication and presentation skills and the ability to teach at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels in relevant subjects within Finance & Accountancy (especially Islamic Capital Markets, Green Finance, Sustainable Development).

This full-time (36.25 hour) post is offered on a 3-year fixed term contract and is available from September 2022.

The successful candidate will be required to participate in administrative duties relating to various aspects of the work of the College as assigned by the Head of College, including the effective delivery of the College's quality assurance systems and other related activities, and the promotion of the College's programmes and activities. The successful candidate will also be expected to contribute to the delivery of Community Education classes and be at all times an excellent ambassador for the College.
